ANALYSIS / ADDITIONAL INFORMATION: The City of Austin Art in Public Places (AIPP) program of the Cultural Arts Division, Economic Development Department, sought to commission a professional visual artist to design and create artwork for Phase 1 of the Colorado Streetscape Art in Public Places project in downtown Austin.

The goal of this project was to develop a fresh and innovative approach to design within a restricted environment; consider the diverse community served by the street enhancements, including downtown residents, tourists and the local business community; and consider the unique landscape and history of Colorado Street.

Dharmesh Patel and Autumn Ewalt (Animalis Works LLC) of Austin, TX were awarded the commission and created *Crystalline*, a series of four polished stainless steel sculptures installed along Colorado Street, between Third and Seventh Streets. One sculpture was installed in fall 2013; the remaining three sculptures will be installed in March 2014.
