

ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CITY CODE SECTION 12-4-64(D) TO ADD TWO 20 MILES PER HOUR SCHOOL ZONES ON SEGMENTS OF TURTLE ROCK ROAD AND BROADMEADE AVENUE AND ONE 25 MILES PER HOUR SCHOOL ZONE ON A SEGMENT OF ANDERSON MILL ROAD FOR STUDENTS ATTENDING LIVE OAK ELEMENTARY SCHOOL AND DEERPARK MIDDLE SCHOOL; AND TO PROVIDE FOR EMERGENCY PASSAGE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:

PART 1. Section 12-4-64(D) (*Table of Speed Limits*) is amended to add:

Turtle Rock Road from 661 feet north of Pineridge Drive to Anderson Mill Road (20 mph for students attending Live Oak Elementary School and Deerpark Middle School)

Broadmeade Avenue from Anderson Mill Road to 120 feet north of Anderson Mill Road (20 mph for students attending Live Oak Elementary School and Deerpark Middle School)

Anderson Mill Road from 296 feet east of Villa Park Drive to 59 feet east of Sherbourne Street (25 mph for students attending Live Oak Elementary School and Deerpark Middle School)

PART 2. The amendments made in this ordinance are based on the results of a traffic engineering investigation, or “speed study,” attached as Exhibit A.

PART 3. The amendment made in this ordinance shall be incorporated in alphabetical order and the existing entries reordered accordingly.

PART 4. Council finds that school is in session, and the need for a school zone at this site constitutes an emergency. Because of this emergency, this ordinance takes effect immediately on its passage for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety.
