

ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CITY CODE SECTION 12-4-64(D) TO ADD 20 MILES PER HOUR SCHOOL ZONES ON SEGMENTS OF TANGLEBRIAR TRAIL AND EL SALIDO PARKWAY FOR STUDENTS ATTENDING PURPLE SAGE ELEMENTARY SCHOOL; AND TO PROVIDE FOR EMERGENCY PASSAGE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:

PART 1. Section 12-4-64(D) (*Table of Speed Limits*) is amended to add:

Tanglebriar Trail from 20 feet south of Bobcat Trail to 52 feet north of El Salido Parkway (20 mph for students attending Purple Sage Elementary School)

El Salido Parkway from 49 feet east of Aloe Vera Trail to 53 feet west of Morning Star Trail (20 mph for students attending Purple Sage Elementary School)

PART 2. The amendments made in this ordinance are based on the results of a traffic engineering investigation, or “speed study,” attached as Exhibit A.

PART 3. The amendment made in this ordinance shall be incorporated in alphabetical order and the existing entries reordered accordingly.

PART 4. Council finds that school is in session, and the need for a school zone at this site constitutes an emergency. Because of this emergency, this ordinance takes effect immediately on its passage for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety.
