<p>In order to modify or alter the existing speed limit of a street, Texas laws require that a traffic engineering investigation be performed. Williamson County prior to annexation of this area by the City of Austin implemented a speed limit of 25 miles per hour, during certain times on Anderson Mill Road for students attending Spicewood Elementary School. After a traffic engineering study reviewing Williamson County's findings, the Austin Transportation Department recommends adopting the previous recommendation by Williamson County to reflect the existing field conditions by adding the following amendment to City Code Section 12-4-64(D) (Table of Speed Limits):</p> <p>Add: Anderson Mill Road from 155 feet west of Nene Drive to 23 feet east of Burmaster Lane. (25 MPH School Zone)</p>
