#### 1. C14H-2004-0025

#### Worley House, 802 E. 47<sup>th</sup> Street

Proposal: Replace the existing deteriorated roof with either slate or synthetic slate.

Applicant: Ellen Williams, owner

City Staff: Steve Sadowsky, Historic Preservation Office, 974-6454 Committee Recommendation: The Committee suggested use of a material closer to the existing material than the then-proposed standing seam metal, and recommended that the applicant salvage roof tiles as artifacts. Staff Recommendation: Approve the Certificate of Appropriateness. The applicant has not yet decided whether to go with a true slate or a synthetic slate roof, but the appearance of the roof will be similar to the existing roofing.

Staff Recommendation: Consider an alternative to removing the glass block that will maintain the historic look and provider a safer, non-slip walking surface.
