 121,074 adults in Central Texas cannot read or struggle with reading.

(2003 National Assessment of Adult Literacy)

 43% of all adults with lowest literacy levels live in poverty.

(2003 National Assessment of Adult Literacy)

 Children's success in school depends on the literacy level of their parents or guardians.

  - Customized lessons based on geographic location, skill level, and goals


