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Additional Backup Information

This contract with SEEPEX, Inc., Arlington, TX, is for the purchase of six progressive polymer cavity pumps for the Hornsby Bend Wastewater Treatment Plant. These pumps are to replace worn-out units at the Thickener Building. The Seepex design is a split stator with less wear parts than the current units. This purchase will allow for annual repairs to be made in place to reduce down time. The current units are going on 20 years old and are at the end of their life cycle. This purchase will allow for a complete change to the new design. The pumps are needed to mix polymer with the sludge for dewatering.

Seepex Inc. is the sole manufacturer and distributor of these pumps and holds a patent on its design.
