# Additional Backup Information

In June 2013, Texas state law was amended to allow breweries to sell beer that is produced on-site for on-site consumption. On October 3, 2013, the City Council initiated an amendment to Title 25 to allow breweries in Austin to sell alcoholic beverages produced on-site for on-site consumption. The sale of these alcoholic beverages for on-site consumption would be permitted if the brewery is at least 540 ft. from any single-family residential use, and conditional for a brewery within 540 ft. of any single-family use. In addition, the sales and consumption area will be limited, and on-site parking will be required.
