

ORDINANCE NO. 20140417-056

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 20121011-069, RELATING TO PEDICABS, BY EXTENDING THE MORATORIUM ON NEW PEDICAB PERMITS UNTIL JULY 23, 2014, AND PROVIDING FOR EMERGENCY PASSAGE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:

PART 1. Part 1 of Ordinance number 20121011-069, is amended to read:


No new pedicabs will be permitted until July 23, 2014 [~~April 23, 2014~~]; those currently permitted may remain in operation, subject to continued evaluation by the Austin Transportation Department. If a pedicab is damaged irreparably during this period its permit may be applied to a new tricycle-type pedicab, but not a new trailer-type pedicab. After July 23, 2014 [~~April 23, 2014~~], a cap on total permits for pedicabs shall be considered.

PART 2. Council finds that the need to extend the moratorium on new pedicab permits constitutes an emergency. Because of this emergency, this ordinance takes effect immediately on its passage for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
