7 8	PART 1. City Code Section 8-3-1 (<i>Alcoholic Beverages Prohibited</i>) is amended to read as follows:
9	§ 8-3-1 ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES PROHIBITED.
10 11	Except as provided in Section 8-3-5 (<i>Temporary Sales of Beverages and Food</i>), a person may not knowingly sell, possess, or consume an alcoholic beverage in:
12 13	 (1) the fences, enclosed area surrounding a swimming pool in a park, or within 100 feet of an unenclosed swimming pool in a park;
14 15	(2) a recreation facility or adjacent outdoor area that is part of the recreation facility including a field, playground, parking lot, play slab, or playscape;
16 17	 (3) all or part of a park or playground designated by the director as being an area in which the sale, possession, or consumption of alcohol is prohibited;
18	(4) the playing area or dugout area of an athletic field;
19	(5) a school district/playground area; [or]
20	(6) a nature preserve <u>; or</u>
21	(7) <u>a pedestrian bridge</u>
22 23	PART 2. City Code Section 10-6-1 (<i>Definitions</i>) is amended to add a definition of "pedestrian bridge" and to renumber the remaining definitions accordingly:
24 25	(7) PEDESTRIAN BRIDGE means a bridge designed for pedestrians or cyclists to cross an obstacle such as a waterway.
26 27	PART 3. City Code Section 10-6-2 (<i>Smoking Prohibited</i>) is amended to add a new Subsection (F) to read as follows:
28	(F) A person commits an offense if the person smokes on a pedestrian bridge.
