## Additional Backup Information

The Susanna Dickinson and Joseph Hannig Museum is both a tribute to the Battle of the Alamo as well as a tribute to the early growth, development and history of Austin. The stories that should also be told are the experiences of the Mexicans and the African Americans in Central Texas. This project is an effort to gather oral histories of people of Austin who are not usually given the opportunities to tell their stories.

The purpose of this request is to support Oral History Project: Conversations to Create Unity. This project has received the support of Baylor University.
