Typical GSI includes landscape stormwater features (e.g., rain gardens and vegetated strips) and restoration projects in the interfacing areas between land and rivers, creeks and/or streams. The landscape features and engineered systems of GSI reduce impacts from built environments by using natural processes to control the quantity and quality of rainwater runoff, improving water quality protection and erosion control.
