## **Prospective Expiration Periods**

## May 22, 2014

Motion is to 2<sup>nd</sup> reading draft posted in backup. Provide text of motion to City Clerk and make available for review on the dais.

<u>Summary of motion</u>: Move to amend Section 25-1-552 to give projects an automatic life of 9-years, unless they expire under the general provision whereby "if all permits for a project expire, the project expires" or receive additional time because a site plan remains active at the end of the project life. Also move to amend this section to allow projects that begin with a Fair Notice application to remain alive if they submit a permit application before the Fair Notice expires.

<u>Text of motion</u>: In Section 25-1-552, at pages 10-11 of the ordinance, delete Subsections (B), (C), (E), (F), and (G), add new Subsections (B) & (C) to read as follows, and reletter the remaining subsections accordingly:

- (B) If the vesting date approved for a project under Section 25-1-541 (Vested Rights Determination) is based on a fair notice application (new project) submitted under Section 25-1-536 (Fair Notice Application), the project expires the later of:
  - (1) one year after the date the application was submitted; or
  - (2) if a permit application is submitted before the fair notice application expires, on the expiration date applicable to that permit under this section.
- (C) Except as provided in Subsection (B) of this section or in Section 25-1-551(C) (Expirations Generally), a project expires nine years after the vesting date approved for the project under Section 25-1-541 (Vested Rights Determination).
