Additional Backup Information						

On October 12, 2013, an emergency repair contract (# CT 220014041000462) was entered into with Peabody General Contractor, Inc., Dripping Springs, TX for the repair of concrete structures at the Mabel Davis Leachate Lift Station off Parker Lane due to flooding caused by heavy rains. The rains caused the concrete structures to float which resulted in damage to three underground vaults and approximately 50 feet of pipe. The facility is located near a Public Park and directly adjacent to an elementary school.

Due to the discharge of wastewater in the area, under the provisions of the Local Government Code 252.022 (2) which made it necessary to preserve and protect the public health and safety of municipality's residents, normal purchasing procedures could not be followed.
