

Update to UFB on Cemeteries Master Plan Tree Inventory

6-18-14

1. 6,422 total tree points inventoried
 - a. 4,895 protected size trees (8 inches or greater)
 - b. 567 heritage size trees (24 inches or greater)
 - i. Live oak: 230
 - ii. Post oak: 50
 - iii. Pecan: 39
 - c. 295 dead trees
 - d. 925 stumps
2. Age Structure
 - a. Largest DBH class in the 8" to 18" range
3. Species Composition (in descending order)
 - a. Live oak: 1,076 trees
 - b. Cedar elm: 1,043 trees
 - c. Crapemyrtle: 858 trees
 - d. Ligustrum: 401 trees
4. Health Condition
 - a. Proportion of vigor health and structure health of trees mimic each other
 - b. Largest portions of trees fall in fair and good condition respectively
 - c. Over 4% of trees are dead
5. Disclaimer
 - a. After data cleanup, the grand total of trees surveyed will likely be smaller
 - b. These numbers include a portion of unmaintained natural areas
 - c. *Unknown* species will be identified and cleaned up
