ANALYSIS / ADDITIONAL INFORMATION: The total amount of fees and requirements waived for this item are estimated at \$2,555,655.

The total estimated fiscal impact of this item is \$2,555,665 in fee waivers and requirements. Waiving fees for this project results in unrealized revenue for the following funds and departments: Austin Water Utility (\$1,405,665), Aviation (\$2,000), Transportation (\$871,000) and the General Fund (\$192,000), which includes the Planning and Development Review and Fire Departments. Although budgeted revenue for fees is based upon historical data and not necessarily upon specific events, the waiver of these fees reduces potential revenues that could be realized.
