Budget Estimate

The current budget estimate for renovation and improvements necessary to occupy the proposed house on Rainey Street is based upon limited information regarding overall condition of the house and unknown infrastructure needs of final location. The first step in proceeding with the list of renovation and improvements listed above would be a Conditions Assessment and Feasibility Study phase performed by outside consultants to verify needs, priorities and potential locations. Currently staff cannot produce a fiscal impact analysis due to lack of empirical evidence regarding the integrity of the house. It should also be noted that this effort is **unfunded** within the current CIP.

PARD would like to offer the following considerations regarding the fiscal impact of transferring ownership of the house on Rainey Street:

- Lead and asbestos abatement
- Conditions Assessment for structural and MEP performed by outside consultant
- Significant HVAC, Fire and Security system upgrades
- Roof, window and general weatherization
- Building and site will need all appropriate utilities to serve building (water, wastewater, electric, gas, etc.)
- Building and site will need to be converted from residential use and brought up to all
 pertinent ADA and COA Commercial Design Standards for public accessibility
- Building entries and interior floor layout will need to be modified to meet ADA standards
- To permanently locate the house will require architectural/engineering services If approved by the City Council, the proposed re-use plan is for a History Center, and specific programming requirements will need to be determined.
