Additional Backup Information

On May 22, 2014, the City Council approved a rezoning ordinance on all three readings. The final rezoning ordinance contained a partially incorrect zoning description due to the unintentional omission of a historic landmark (H) designation that previously existed on the property. The proposed ordinance would correct the zoning description to family residence-historic landmark-historic district-neighborhood conservation combining district-neighborhood plan (SF-3-H-HD-NCCD-NP) combining district zoning. All other conditions of zoning will remain unchanged.
