Chromatograph-Mass Spectrometer (UPLC-MS). The Austin Police Department (APD) purchased this UPLC-MS in						

2011 and the maintenance agreement provided with the purchase is now expired.

APD is purchasing the total assurance plan which is fully comprehensive. Performance Maintenance (PM) visits are included.
