Additional Backup Information

This action will expand the Austin Downtown Public Improvement District (PID) by one parcel, as requested by the property owner. Texas Local Government Code, Chapter 372, requires that the governing body of the municipality hold a public hearing on the advisability of the expansion.

Under the Green Water Treatment Plant Master Development Agreement between the City of Austin and TC Green Water Master Development, LLC, the developer agreed to voluntarily request to become part of the PID and pay applicable assessments to benefit the PID. The property, contiguous to the current PID boundary, is bordered by Cesar Chavez Street on the south, San Antonio Street on the east, the extension of Second Street on the north, and the extension of Nueces Street on the west.
