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### Subject

Authorize award and execution of a 36-month requirements service contract with BALCONES RESOURCES, INC. DBA BALCONES RECYCLING, INC., to provide recycling processing services for City in-house recycling collection in an amount not to exceed \$123,000, with three 12-month extension options in an amount not to exceed \$41,000 per extension option, for a total contract amount not to exceed \$246,000.

### Amount and Source of Funding

Funding in the amount of \$10,250 is available in the Fiscal Year 2013-2014 Operating Budget of the Austin Resource Recovery Department. Funding for the remaining thirty-three months of the original contract period and extension options is contingent upon available funding in future budgets.

### Fiscal Note

There is no unanticipated fiscal impact. A fiscal note is not required.

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MBE / WBE:	This contract will be awarded in compliance with City Code Chapter 2-9C (Minority-Owned and Women-Owned Business Enterprise Procurement Program). No subcontracting opportunities were identified; therefore, no goals were established for this contract.
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### Additional Backup Information

This contract will provide for the processing and marketing services for single-stream recyclable material collected by City crews at approximately 160 City facilities. On a daily basis, the vendor will receive, sort, process, store, market, and sell the recyclable material. Items intended for recycling include newsprint, old corrugated containers, mixed paper, plastics, used aluminum beverage cans, tin cans, glass, and scrap metal. For the current fiscal year, the City estimates collecting over 450 tons of single-stream recyclable material from City facilities. Approximately 70% of this tonnage is paper, 23% of this tonnage is containers (plastic, steel cans, aluminum, and glass) and the remaining 7% is residuals. The list of materials may change during the life of the contract, as requested by the Austin Resource Recovery Department.
