Additional Backup Information					

This contract with ADB Airfield Solutions, Columbus, Ohio, is for the continuation of preventative maintenance and training for the Airfield Lighting and Control Monitoring System (ALCMS) used by the Aviation Department's air traffic control tower to control the airfield lighting and sign systems during aircraft landings and departures. The preventative maintenance services will include all hardware and software installations, upgrades, programming, data base management, system modifications and configurations, and certified maintenance training. The system has been covered under warranty so this contract is now needed due to the warranty period expiring.

ADB Airfield Solutions is the manufacturer of the system and sole provider for the maintenance and support of this proprietary system.
