I am writing regarding case C14-2014-0070 – 2309 Montopolis Drive & 6500 Carson Ridge. Zoning change from SF-3 to SF-5, please approve. The Montopolis Neighborhood Contact Team met with the owners/applicants on June  $11^{th}$  and July  $10^{th}$ . Members of the MNP Contact Team also met with Mr. Lee Heckman of the Planning and Development Review Department on July  $10^{th}$ .

At the July 10<sup>th,</sup> Montopolis Neighborhood Contact Team meeting we agreed to take a neutral stand regarding the above zoning case due to Dr. Fred McGhee's strong disapproval to the zoning change, even though we felt that the zoning was compatible to the multi-family zoning to the north of the property and to the condos to the south of the property.

On July 22<sup>nd</sup>, the Planning Commission approved the zoning change for the above stated case. On Sunday, August 3<sup>rd</sup> there was a meeting with Simon and Ronaldo Brown-Valdez, Dr. Fred McGhee and myself. After a lengthy discussion, Dr. Fred McGhee agreed to the zoning change with 9 units being built on the property. We talked about this case being approved on consent, since there was no Valid Petition and Dr. Fred McGhee's agreement with the owner/applicants.
