This contract will provide delivery, installation, preventative maintenance, and repair services for two conveyorized Xray screening stations and two metal detection systems at City Hall. One screening station and one metal detection system will be placed at the north entrance of City Hall, and the other one at the south entrance.

The X-ray screening equipment is designed to inspect bags, briefcases, parcels, and other containers for the presence of weapons, explosives, and other threat items.
