### Accessibility

#### TNC Best Options

- Asked TNCs for their best recommendations to meet the needs of our community who needs accessible service.
- Haven't responded yet, but both companies confirm they are working on recommendations.

#### Ground Transportation Services – Accessibility Fund

 Require all GT services that don't meet accessibility standards to pay into a fund that would fund accessible services.

#### California Public Utilities Commission model

Required TNCs to present a plan to the CPUC

#### Chicago, IL feature

 Uber app has capability for the user to enter a special code that will show them the accessible vehicles in the area.





### Fleet Size



City requires data to determine impact of fleet size.

- Currently no recommendation to cap fleet size, which would possibly call for additional permits for taxis.
- City will monitor data to ensure fleet sizes are manageable and companies are responsive.







### **Local Presence**

- Local presence necessary to handle <u>complaints</u> and <u>lost and found.</u>
- Question we will need to be able to answer: Who do our residents call if they have a problem with a TNC?







# Trade Dress/Vehicle Marking

- <u>Temporary markings</u> so passengers, enforcements officers and emergency responders know they vehicle is operating as a TNC.
- TNC would design, have already done so in some other cities.
