- c. Pursuant to the Texas Local Government Code Section 143.081(d) and Rule 15.04 of the City of Austin Fire Fighters', Police Officers' and Emergency Medical Personnel Civil Service Commission Rules and Regulations, consider the appointment of a three-member board to examine a EMS Medic II Field.
- d. Hear and decide any appeals from the Police Sergeant Written Exam administered on September 15, 2014 pursuant to the Texas Local Government Code Chapter 143.034, Article 13 of the Agreement between the City of Austin and the Austin Police Association and Rule 7 of the City of Austin Fire Fighters' and Police Officers' Civil Service Commission Rules and Regulations.
