### COMMISSION ACTION

There was discussion regarding the ordinance as now written. Bill Stoll suggested that the Planning Commission, with suggestions from the appropriate committee of the Environmental Board, develop and recommend to the City Council a statement of principles, a plan of action, and priorities in development of ordinances. He suggested the Planning Commission invite citizen advice from the technical private sector in the development of these items and that this would be accomplished in a period of 30 days and that the Planning Commission would solicit Environmental Board and citizen advice on an ongoing basis on the results of the interim Lake Austin Watershed Ordinance. Brad Coleman. a citizen and developer, explained how the citizen advice from a technical standpoint could be coordinated with the Planning Commission. He felt the committee could be composed of approximately seven to nine members who would be engineers, architects, developers, planners, surveyors and property owners who would be working with the ordinance and most affected thereby. He felt that interpretation of the ordinance would be the greatest problem; also felt that monitoring would be a problem. Mr. Dixon felt this to be a fine suggestion and felt it is workable but was concerned as to how it could be made to work. Mr. Guerrero felt that if a committee should be appointed, this must be done by the Council and not by the Planning Commission.

#### COMMISSION VOTE

Mr. Stoll moved that the chairman designate a subcommittee to work with the appropriate subcommittee of the Environmental Board in developing this plan of action and that the Planning Commission recommend to the City Council the endorsement, or creation, of a volunteer citizen comcommittee as an ongoing committee making their reports to the Planning Commission which would in turn submit them to the City Council. Mr. Dixon seconded the motion.

Mr. Jagger stated that the Council had asked the Planning Commission to give them a recommendation on the Lake Austin Plan. In reality what we are saying is that we have studied the Plan, we think it has some good aspects, we have approached it from the standpoint of trying to determine if we could recommend it in principle, but have concluded that it has so many wide aspects that we cannot; therefore, we are recommending that the Plan not be adopted at this time. We are preparing to proceed to work on trying to extract from the Plan the aspects that we think we recommend to the Council as a specific plan of action for implementing further things in the Lake Austin watershed area. It would be helpful to have an advisory committee of some sort to work with this. I think we can honestly say this study is interesting and valuable but its ramifications are so great that we are not prepared to recommend its adoption in principle, and he so amended the motion. Mr. Stoll accepted the amendment.

It was stressed by Mrs. Bartz that the usage of pornographic materials is not compatible with residential neighborhoods and it was requested there be a stipulation that such establishments could not be closer than 500 feet to any school, residence, hospital, or church. It was felt that something more restrictive than "C" could be used. There was discussion as to how this could be drafted into the ordinance; the number of seats for a certain size screen, amusements to be amusements and not movie theatres. Mr. Jagger suggested that perhaps a C-3 zoning could be created for amusement centers or that a special permit process be used. There was discussion regarding the bookstores and how this could be handled. Mr. Meinrath felt that it would be ill advised for a book store to be governed by a special permit. He suggested separating adult entertainment and book stores.
