The City of Austin Art in Public Places (AIPP) program of the Cultural Arts Division, Economic Development Department sought to commission a professional visual artist to design and create artwork for the Pressler Street Extension AIPP project, which is a 2012 Transportation Bond project to improve connectivity issues along the Loop 1/MoPAC corridor.						
The goals of the AIPP project are to develop a thoughtful and innovative approach to design within a complex environment with multiple stakeholders, reflecting the unique cultural identity of the project area while creating artwork which is durable enough to hold up to the rigors of the site conditions and is very low maintenance.						
A Request for Qualifications (RFQ) was issued on April 23, 2014 to professional visual artists and artist teams, at least						

18 years of age, who live or work in the state of Texas. The Selection Panel met with Advisors on June 19, 2014 to review the 27 eligible responses submitted by the advertised deadline, including images of past work, resume, and letter of interest. The Selection Panel selected four finalists: Melissa Borrell (Austin, TX); Jeff Clarke and Joel Nolan (Austin, TX); Dharmesh Patel and Autumn Ewalt (Austin, TX); and Hatch Workshop (Austin, TX). The Selection Panel conducted interviews on July 8, 2014 and unanimously voted for Dharmesh Patel and Autumn Ewalt (Animalis Works, LLC) of Austin, TX as the artist and for the artist team of Jeff Clarke and Joel Nolan of Austin, TX as the alternate.
