ANALYSIS / ADDITIONAL INFORMATION: The Austin Parks and Recreation Department (PARC) Senior Transportation Program is a Capital Area Council of Governments (CAPCOG) grant reimbursement transportation service created in conjunction with the CAPCOG Senior Congregate Meal program to assist with providing transportation to PARC Congregate Meal locations.

The Senior Transportation Program mission is to improve the quality of and create mobility solutions involving transportation services for senior citizens 60 years of age and older. PARC Senior Transportation currently offers the following services:

- Free Regular Routes to PARC's eight (8) Congregate Meal Locations: Alamo Recreation Center, Conley-Guerrero Senior Activity Center, Dove Springs Recreation Center, Gus Garcia Recreation Center, Metz Recreation Center, South Austin Senior Activity Center, and Virginia Brown Recreation Center
- Reserve-a-Ride for non-medical emergency medical appointments and errands
- Group field trip group travel

The General Fund will not be required to contribute to this grant.
