<p>The Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) is offering to sell the Bull Creek property to the City for \$28,500,000, with \$400,000 in closing costs for a total amount not to exceed \$28,900,000. The sale of the property is contingent on the release of any and all rights and interests of the Texas State Cemetery Committee in the property, including the modification or termination of the interagency maintenance agreement with the Texas Facilities Commission addressing the portion of the Bull Creek property in which the Committee has rights.</p> <p>The sale is contingent on agreement to the terms and form of a lease with the Department of Motor Vehicles. The term of the lease will be for 3 years at \$1 per year as the property is needed by either TxDOT or the Texas</p>				

Department of Motor Vehicles. The land to be covered by the lease will only be the area currently in use.

On September 8, 2014, the City Council approved a resolution directing the City Manager to enter into negotiations related to the acquisition of the property and to conduct all due diligence before purchasing. All due diligence has been completed.
