This contract with Seepex Inc. is for the purchase of repair parts for Seepex Smart Conveying Technology (SCT) progressive cavity pumps for plant repairs. With the conversion of several critical pumps to the SCT design, a contract is needed to support the new pumps. At present, Austin Water Utility has Seepex progressive cavity and polymer pumps at Hornsby Bend, Govalle and South Austin Regional WWTPs. There are future plans to convert in other areas of the utility. The contract will provide for a readily available supply of these parts to be stocked at the plants for emergency repairs. This is the first time that a contract has been established for these pump parts.

Seepex, Inc. designed, manufactures, and offers the SCT progressive cavity pump design. Globally, Seepex is the only company that offers this pump design and the associated parts for them and holds a patent on the design. Seepex is providing the City a 15% discount from their pricelist.
