INSPECTIONS

Motion Amend Part 3 Section (B) (4) of the proposed ordinance as follows:

(4) To operate a vehicle for a TNC, a driver must have:

- (a) a valid driver's license;**
- (b) proof of vehicle registration;**
- (c) current automobile liability insurance;**
- (d) reached the age of 21 years;**

(e) proof that the vehicle to be operated for the TNC has successfully passed a 20-point inspection conducted by a mechanic certified by the State of Texas to perform state inspections. This proof must be carried in the subject vehicle on trips operated through the use of a TNC app. These inspections must include testing of the following:

- 1. Emergency brakes;**
- 2. Foot brakes;**
- 3. Steering mechanism;**
- 4. Windshield;**
- 5. Rear window and other glass;**
- 6. Windshield wipers;**
- 7. Headlights;**
- 8. Tail lights;**
- 9. Turn indicator lights;**

- 10. Stop lights;**
- 11. Front seat adjustment mechanism;**
- 12. Doors (open, close, lock);**
- 13. Horn;**
- 14. Speedometer;**
- 15. Bumpers;**
- 16. Muffler and exhaust system;**
- 17. Condition of tires, including tread depth;**
- 18. Interior and exterior rear view mirrors;**
- 19. Safety belts for drivers and passengers; and**
- 20. Fire extinguisher**
