## INSPECTIONS

Motion Amend Part 3 Section (B) (4) of the proposed ordinance as follows:

- (4) To operate a vehicle for a TNC, a driver must have:
  - (a) a valid driver's license;
  - (b) proof of vehicle registration;
  - (c) current automobile liability insurance;
  - (d) reached the age of 21 years;
- (e) proof that the vehicle to be operated for the TNC has successfully passed a 20-point inspection conducted by a mechanic certified by the State of Texas to perform state inspections. This proof must be carried in the subject vehicle on trips operated through the use of a TNC app. These inspections must include testing of the following:
  - 1. Emergency brakes;
  - 2. Foot brakes;
  - 3. Steering mechanism;
  - 4. Windshield;
  - 5. Rear window and other glass;
  - 6. Windshield wipers;
  - 7. Headlights;
  - 8. Tail lights;
  - 9. Turn indicator lights;

- 10. Stop lights;
- 11. Front seat adjustment mechanism;
- 12. Doors (open, close, lock);
- 13. Horn;
- 14. Speedometer;
- 15. Bumpers;
- 16. Muffler and exhaust system;
- 17. Condition of tires, including tread depth;
- 18. Interior and exterior rear view mirrors;
- 19. Safety belts for drivers and passengers; and
- 20. Fire extinguisher
