### Comments:

- 1. Fire Hazard. Reducing the side setback to 3 1/2 feet produces an even greater fire hazard than already exists on these closely spaced lots. This was evident in last year's house fire on Griswold St, less than one block away.
- 2. Reduction of Flora and Fauna Along Creek. Increasing the max building and impervious coverage will dramatically impact our wet weather creek. It currently is a mini wildlife corridor teaming with hawks, owls, and various mammals. Please don't turn this natural creek into a drainage ditch like Waller Creek by allowing an over sized house and reducing the habitat that surrounds it.
