Additional Backup Information

On April 17, 2014, Council directed the City Manager to process an ordinance which would prohibit discrimination based on the source of an individual's income. The proposed ordinance defines "source of income" to mean "lawful, regular, and verifiable income including, but not limited to, housing vouchers and other subsidies provided by government or nongovernmental entities, child support, or spousal maintenance, but does not include future gifts."

During 1st reading, Council approved the following changes to staff's proposed ordinance:

- Add a new section 5-1-19 that exempts rental of a single family dwelling, duplex, triplex, or four plex dwelling, except that the prohibition against discriminatory advertising shall apply to these dwellings.
- Add "regular" to the definition of "source of income."
- Make ordinance effective on December 1, 2014.
