Additional Backup Information

In March 2014, City Council initiated changes to Austin's Land Development Code to remove impediments to the construction of multifamily units that are 500 square feet or less in size. Although Austin's current code allows for the construction of these types of units, there are density caps and parking requirements that may inhibit their construction. The proposed changes provide that multifamily units that are located within a transit oriented development district or on a core transit corridor (CTC), or future CTC that are 500 square feet or less, and provide on-site affordable units will have a minimum site area requirement and minimum parking requirement of zero.
