The selected firm shall provide environmental assessment services; coordinate assessment and remediation planning activities with City staff, site owners, stakeholders and Brownfields Program staff as necessary; attend and (as necessary) facilitate public meetings regarding site activities; evaluate available technical information to develop site-specific scopes of work for City and EPA approval; conduct all necessary technical activities to complete environmental assessment activities and cleanup planning to achieve site closure in accordance with site-specific scopes of work, including but not limited to: project management; communication with Brownfields Program staff regarding project progress, scheduling of field work and budget updates; project-specific health and safety plan development and implementation; remedial/corrective action work plan development; quality assurance project plan development; soil, groundwater, and vapor sampling; confirmation sampling, contaminant identification, delineation, and fate and transport modeling; monitoring well installation and groundwater gauging; site and monitoring well surveying; containerization, characterization, and appropriate disposal of investigation and remediation derived wastes; and conduct asbestos/lead-based paint inspections and surveys and develop cost estimates for asbestos and/or lead-based paint abatement.

This authorization provides for funding of services related to environmental consulting services.

This request allows for the development of an agreement with the qualified responder that Council selects. If the City is unsuccessful in negotiating a satisfactory agreement with the selected responder, negotiations will cease with that provider. Staff will return to Council so that Council may select another qualified responder and authorize contract negotiations with this provider.

DBE Participation goals stated in the solicitation was 11.42%. The recommended firm) provided a DBE Compliance Plan that met the goals of the solicitation and was approved by the Small and Minority Business Resources Department. The alternate firm provided a DBE Compliance Plan that met the goals of the solicitation and was approved by the Small and Minority Business Resources Department.

Notification of issuance of a Request for Qualifications (RFQ) for the subject services was sent to 444 firms on July 3, 2014. The RFQ was obtained by 78 firms and eight submitted qualification statements. One of the firms was a certified MBE /WBE firm. Of the eight firms evaluated, three firms were short-listed and interviewed. Interviewing of the short-listed firms results in the following recommendation.
