Additional Backup Information							
John Conley, promoter with Conley Sports Productions LLC, submitted a street event application on June 2, 2014 to close various streets described below for the 3M Half Marathon on Sunday, January 25, 2015 and has requested the Austin Transportation Department submit this event to the Council for consideration in compliance with City Code Chapter 14-8. The applicant will pay all fees and meet all ordinance requirements prior to obtaining the event permit. No fees will be waived by the City. Austin Transportation Department offers this request for Council action without recommendation. Under City Code Section 14-8-3(B)(3) ( <i>Restrictions on Issuance of Closure Permit</i> ), the Director may not issue a closure permit without council approval for a right-of-way event if 20 percent or more of the affected persons on any block to be closed or a neighborhood association objects to the closure. This event may receive objections from property owners on the street route, and this action will waive the right of property owners to object. The applicant has requested that Council waive this requirement.							

Under City Code Section 14-8-15(B) which specifies that "if an event has been held for 10 years and has not changed its character, nature, location, or route, the director may approve the following year's event for the same applicant regardless of whether it satisfies the requirements of 14-8-3". The 3M Half Marathon has been successfully and safely conducted in Austin for 21 years. Changes to the race route have been made to adapt to changes in roadways because of construction or development.

<u>Event times</u>: Event starts: 7:00 a.m. - 11:00 a.m. The start line closure starts on January 25 at 3:00 a.m. and the remaining route closures start at 4:00 a.m. After the last runner has safely cleared the course, the barricades will be removed. All roads should be open by 12:30 p.m.

The applicant is in the process of complying with all other requirements for this Street Event. The Austin Transportation Department has no objections to this request contingent on all other requirements being met.
