Subject

Conduct a public hearing and consider an ordinance regarding the East Sixth Street Public Improvement District 2015 assessment roll and authorizing the levying of 2015 assessments.

Amount and Source of Funding

Funding at the approved 2015 assessment rate of \$0.19/\$100 valuation is estimated to produce \$85,989 at a 90% collection rate.

Additional Backup Information

On November 6, 2014, Council approved the 2015 assessment rate for the East Sixth Street Public Improvement District (PID) (at the rate of \$0.19 per \$100 valuation), and approved the proposed 2015 assessment roll (list of property owners subject to the assessment). The assessments paid by property owners fund the PID services.

State law requires the Council conduct a public hearing to consider the proposed assessments. Approval of the assessment rate and proposed roll on November 6, 2014 triggered notices being sent to property owners, giving them an opportunity to review the property valuations prior to the public hearing. Property owners have a statutory right to challenge the assessment placed on their property at the public hearing. Approval of the assessment roll ordinance is the final Council action required in the annual process of approving PID assessments.
