ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE WAIVING OR REIMBURSING CERTAIN FEES AND GRANTING A VARIANCE UNDER CITY CODE CHAPTER 10-3 FOR THE MONTHLY COMMUTER POP-UP BREAKFASTS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:

PART 1. Movability Austin has requested a variance from City Code Section 10-3-1(15)(a) (*Definitions*) regarding the number of times per year allowed for temporary events for the commuter pop-up breakfasts.

PART 2. FINDINGS.

- (A) Movability Austin is a non-profit organization.
- (B) Movability Austin provides monthly commuter pop-up breakfasts for the Austin community as a reward to commuters using alternative transportation choices.
- (C) Movability Austin has committed to take the following actions to prevent any potential health hazards from occurring at its temporary event locations:
 - (1) Food will be purchased from professional, qualified vendors;
 - (2) Food is brought directly to the event site and distributed immediately; and
 - (3) Food is pre-packaged and individually wrapped.
- (D) It is in the City's best interest to promote alternative transportation choices and supporting frequent rewards provided by Movability Austin helps build a sense of community and a network of support among commuters.
- **PART 3.** Council grants a variance to City Code Section 10-3-1(15)(a). One commuter pop-up breakfast per month will take place at various locations in Austin for the period December 1, 2014 through December 31, 2015 (the "Event Period").
- **PART 4.** Council waives or reimburses the Health and Human Services Temporary Vending Permit Fees in the amount of \$1,274 during the Event Period.
