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## ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE WAIVING CERTAIN FEES AND REQUIREMENTS UNDER **CHAPTER** 14-8; WAIVING CERTAIN CITY CODE OTHER REQUIREMENTS; AUTHORIZING PAYMENTS. AND **PAYMENT OF** CERTAIN COSTS; WAIVING CERTAIN CITY CODE REQUIREMENTS FOR THE CITY CO-SPONSORED 2015 SOUTH BY SOUTHWEST CONFERENCES AND FESTIVALS MARCH 13-22, 2015; AND ESTABLISHING A FRAMEWORK **FOR** LONG-TERM PLANNING FOR SOUTH BY **SOUTHWEST** CONFERENCES AND FESTIVALS.

## BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:

## **PART 1.** FINDINGS.

The council finds the following:

- (1) The City of Austin (the "City") has been the host city for the South By Southwest Conferences and Festivals (the "SXSW Event") since the first SXSW Event in 1987; and
- (2) The SXSW Event brings hallmark cultural value to the City by featuring creative talent, including musical performers, film producers, technology trailblazers, and speakers who are leaders in their respective industries; and
- (3) The SXSW Event has grown into an internationally recognized event that attracts attendees and companies from all over the world to Austin, with an economic impact of over \$1 billion for the City of Austin over the past five years; and
- (4) The SXSW Event is a City Co-Sponsored Event, providing a range of free public concerts and other popular cultural events attended by thousands of Austin residents annually; and
- (5) City services provided during the SXSW Event protect and benefit everyone in downtown Austin, including local businesses, the Austin community, visitors, and SXSW Event attendees and participants; and
- (6) Safety during the SXSW Event is the top priority for SXSW, LLC ("SXSW") and the City; and

- (21) Fire Inspection and Permit Costs (Austin Fire); and
- (22) Barricade Costs (Austin Transportation)

Total payments authorized not to exceed \$600,000.

## Total amount waived and authorized not to exceed \$950,000.

**PART 3.** Council waives certain closure notice requirements that allow affected individuals and neighborhood associations to object to street closures under City Code Chapter 14-8 (*Temporary Closure for Right of Way Event*) for the 2015 SXSW Event.

**PART 4.** Council modifies the following City Code requirements and restrictions during the period of March 13-22, 2015. Nothing in these modifications is intended to waive required City staff approvals.

- (1) With respect to events during the Spring Festival Season that are produced or represented by SXSW for the SXSW Event, the restriction on maximum number of days for a multi-day special events permit in City Code Sections 9-2-36 (*Types of Live Music Permits*) and 9-2-38 (*Multi-day Special Events Permit*) is modified to allow a multi-day permit for a maximum of 10 days during the Spring Festival Season.
- (2) With respect to events during the Spring Festival Season that are produced or represented by SXSW for the SXSW Event, the restriction in City Code Section 9-2-38(F) (*Multi-day Special Events Permits*) is modified to allow a permit to be issued for a site or property that is used as a parking lot if the lot is not leased by an adjacent commercial structure.
- (3) With respect to events during the Spring Festival Season that are produced or represented by SXSW for the SXSW Event, the restriction the notice of application for multi-day permits in City Code Section 9-2-54 (*Notice of Application*) is modified to waive the notice requirement in Subsection 9-2-54(B).
- (4) With respect to events during the Spring Festival Season that are produced or represented by SXSW for the SXSW Event, City Code Section 25-10-158 (*Special Event Signs*) is modified as follows:
  - (a) Subsection 25-10-158(B)(1) is modified to allow a maximum of 5 signs;
  - (b) Subsection 25-10-158(B)(2) is modified to allow projected signs that may not exceed the lesser of 75% of the area of a façade or 9000 square feet;
