

ORDINANCE NO. 20141211-178

AN ORDINANCE REZONING AND CHANGING THE ZONING MAP FOR THE PROPERTY GENERALLY KNOWN AS THE ROUTON-ALVAREZ-LOPEZ HOUSE LOCATED AT 809 EAST 9TH STREET IN THE CENTRAL EAST AUSTIN NEIGHBORHOOD PLAN AREA FROM FAMILY RESIDENCE-NEIGHBORHOOD CONSERVATION COMBINING DISTRICT-NEIGHBORHOOD PLAN (SF-3-NCCD-NP) COMBINING DISTRICT TO FAMILY RESIDENCE-HISTORIC LANDMARK -NEIGHBORHOOD CONSERVATION COMBINING DISTRICT-NEIGHBORHOOD PLAN (SF-3-H-NCCD-NP) COMBINING DISTRICT.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:

PART 1. The zoning map established by Section 25-2-191 of the City Code is amended to change the base district from family residence-neighborhood conservation combining district-neighborhood plan (SF-3-NCCD-NP) combining district to family residence-historic landmark -neighborhood conservation combining district-neighborhood plan (SF-3-H-NCCD-NP) combining district on the property described in Zoning Case No. C14H-2011-0002, on file at the Planning and Development Review Department, as follows:


The East 23 feet of Lot 16 and the West 34 feet of Lot 17, Outlot 1, Division B, South part of the Sarah and Lydia Robertson Subdivision, a subdivision in the City of Austin, Travis County, Texas, according to the map or plat of record in Plat Book 2, Page 232 of the Plat Records of Travis County, Texas (the "Property"),

generally known as the Routon-Alvarez-Lopez House, locally known as 809 East 9th Street in the City of Austin, Travis County, Texas, and generally identified in the map attached as Exhibit "A".

PART 2. The Property is subject to Ordinance No. 011213-42 that established the Central East Austin neighborhood plan combining district.

PART 3. This ordinance takes effect on December 22, 2014.
