
STANDARDS FOR REVIEW

The Old West Austin National Register Historic District has no design guidelines for new construction. General design principles for new construction in historic districts call for compatibility with the existing contributing houses in terms of scale, massing, materials, fenestration patterns, and floor-to-ceiling ratios.

Approve as proposed. This is a neo-Traditional house that should be compatible with the character of the district.
