 - Permanent fencing and gates

Commissioning and Start-Up

Water Quality Requirements for Storm Water Pond Discharge

Characteristic	Requirements	Units
pH	6.5 – 8.5	
Total Chlorine	<0.01	mg/L
Total Dissolved Solids	≤400	mg/L

Commissioning and Start-Up

Water Management

- Daily communication between Contractor and COA EV Manager
- Lake water utilized for various tests – Raw water pumps
- Disinfection water treated, tested and logged prior to release
- Re-use of testing & disinfection water where feasible
- Regular communication and coordination with downstream neighbors

Final Stabilization

- Treatment Plant and Raw Water Pump Station
 - Native grasses
 - Native plants
 - Trees - Escarpment plateau seed stock
- Four Points and Spicewood shaft sites
 - Native grasses
- Jollyville Reservoir shaft site
 - Bermuda grass (existing vegetation)
