1. APPROVAL OF MINUTES

a. The minutes from the meeting of December 19, 2014, were approved. Commission member Martinez moved to approve and Commission Vice Chair Edmonds seconded the motion. The motion passed 2-0.

2. NEW BUSINESS

- a. Selection of a chair and vice chair. Per Chapter 143.006, Section (e) of the Texas Local Government Code, each January the members shall elect a chairman and a vice-chairman.
 - Commission Member Martinez moved to select Commission Chair Cobb to another term as Commission Chair and Commission Vice Chair Edmonds seconded the motion. The motion passed 2-0.
 - Commission Vice Chair Edmonds moved to select Commission Member Martinez to Commission Vice Chair, Commission Member Martinez seconded the motion. The motion passed 2-0.

- b. Consider and act upon Chief Rodriguez's request to certify a Cadet Eligibility List in accordance with Article 13, Section 2(c) of the Agreement between the Emergency Medical Services Personnel's Association and the City of Austin.
 - Commission member Martinez moved to approve and Commission Vice Chair Edmonds seconded the motion. The motion passed 2-0.
