Additional Backup Information

On May 22, 2014, Council directed the City Manager to work with stakeholders in the Mueller Development to create a Parking and Transportation Management District for Mueller Development area. Based on community input staff is recommending the establishment of a Parking and Transportation Management District (PTMD) to be managed by the Austin Transportation Department in accordance with the requirements established by Council Resolution No. 20140522-042.

The Austin Transportation Department worked with stakeholders to create the district. A series of stakeholder outreach meetings were held with the different organization:

- Robert Mueller Municipal Airport Plan Implementation Advisory Commission Working Group 08/27/2014 and 10/27/2014
- Austin Transportation Department/Catellus Public Community Meeting 10/30/2014
- Mueller Employment Center Town Center and Mixed Use Community Associations Meeting 11/06/2014

- Mueller Transportation Committee 11/12/2014
- Mueller Neighborhood Association 11/05/2014 and 11/18/2014 and
- Mueller PIAC Meetings 05/13/2014 and 11/13/2014.

The proposed Mueller Parking and Transportation Management District (PTMD boundaries run along East 51st Street, IH 35, the Northwest Greenway, Airport Boulevard, Anchor Lane and Manor Road. The implementation of this PTMD would initially allow for approximately 140 paid parking spaces. The projected 51% of the revenue after City expenses is \$33,310 and would be returned to the PTMD for their proposed projects.
