## Subject

Authorize award and execution of a 36-month contract with CDW GOVERNMENT, LLC., to provide electric visual display systems for Austin-Bergstrom International Airport in an amount not to exceed \$1,600,000, with two 12-month extension options in an amount not to exceed \$200,000 per extension option, for a total contract amount not to exceed \$2,000,000.

## Amount and Source of Funding

Funding in the amount of \$719,213 is available in the Fiscal Year 2014-2015 Capital Budget of the Aviation Department. Funding for the remaining 29-months of the original contract period and extension options are contingent upon available Operational funding in future budgets.

This contract will be awarded in compliance with City Code Chapter 2-9D Minority-Owned and Women-Owned Business Enterprise Procurement Program. No subcontracting opportunities were identified; therefore, no goals were established for this solicitation.

## Additional Backup Information

This contract will provide for the purchase and installation of new displays, mounts, and cables as required to support the Flight Information Display (FID) System at the Austin-Bergstrom International Airport. These are banks of monitors showing flight times and status updates which are located throughout the airport. This contract will provide for the initial replacement of 146 monitors, and then will provide for a supply of monitors and mounts as needed and as the budget allows, for any others which need to be replaced at end of life. The contractor shall provide all equipment, materials, software, labor, and design as required for complete installation and fully operational hardware for 65 of the initial monitors purchased. The remaining monitors purchased through this contract will be installed by Aviation Department personnel.
