



Community Cleanups

Cleanups Turn Key with Keep Austin Beautiful Support

trash bags, gloves, and trash grabbers provided

coordination of trash collection

→ assistance identifying areas in need

→ volunteer recruitment

- 352 cleanups
- 6,070 volunteers
- totaling 29 tons of trash

Clean Sweep

Saturday, April 11, 2015

Largest city-wide cleanup

→ 4,300 volunteers, 130 locations, and 30 tons of trash collected

Clean Lady Bird Lake

Large-scale cleanups of Lady Bird Lake every other month

→ 1,615 volunteers, 20 locations, and 13 tons of trash collected

Adoption Programs

Adopt-a-Creek and Adopt-a-Street

Foster long-term commitments to Austin's streets and creeks.

171 Groups98 Miles Adopted



Use landscaping, improving the build infrastructure, and ongoing maintenance to set a community standard and promote a sense of personal responsibility not to litter.
