1. APPROVAL OF MINUTES

2. CITIZENS' COMMUNICATION

3. STAFF BRIEFINGS AND DISCUSSION

- Laurie Dries (Watershed Protection Department Environmental Scientist) provided an overview of the Sunken Garden Flow Regime Restoration Project.
 - Primary goal is to slow outflow velocity to make spring run more suitable habitat for salamanders.

- Secondary goal was to add an operable sluice gate. After receiving Preliminary Engineering Report, this goal was shown to be most likely not feasible, and possibly counterproductive.
- Robin Camp (Public Works Department Project Manager) gave an update on the progress of the General Grounds Improvements project.
 - Mary Ann Neely asked about plans to address poison ivy in south woods.
 Watershed Protection staff explained that a plan is in place to
 systematically remove invasive species (and some poison ivy) and replant
 with native species. Removal must be done over time to prevent erosion
 of the hillside, which is considered a critical environmental feature.
