HISTORIC LANDMARK COMMISSION MARCH 23, 2015 DEMOLITION AND RELOCATION PERMITS HDP-2015-0121 2502 WILSON STREET

PROPOSAL

Demolish a house believed to have been built in 1948.

ARCHITECTURE

One-story, rectangular-plan, side-gabled frame house with a central, partial-width, front-gabled entry porch on turned wood posts and with a scalloped bargeboard; single and paired 2:2 fenestration.

RESEARCH

There is a water service permit dating from 1935 for this address, but neither of the people named on the permit lived at this address. The area appears to have been south of the city limit until around 1950; no city directory prior to 1952 shows this address, and the 1952 city directory shows the house as vacant. There is another water service permit for (possibly) this address dating from 1948, which appears to be the more likely date of construction. The first known owner and occupant was a military man in the U.S. Air Force. Leon N. Farris, the owner of two barber shops, and his wife, Zora, are shown as the owners and occupants in the mid-1950s; meat cutter Louis H. Matteck and his wife Regina are shown as the owners and occupants from the late 1950s through the early 1960s. Ira D. Moore, the proprietor of Longhorn Disposal Service, owned and occupied the house with his wife, Beverly, from the late 1960s through the mid-1970s. The house was either vacant or a rental property through the 1970s, 1980s, and 1990s.


STAFF COMMENTS

The house does not appear in any City survey.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION

The house may be as old as the mid-1930s (given the water service permit for this address dating from 1935), although the windows in the front of the house appear to be even older than a 1935 construction date. It is possible that the house was built with salvaged materials from an older house, but there is no evidence of its history because it was beyond the city limits – the city directories do not reference a house at this address prior to 1952, there is no building permit for the house, and the front porch (even with its non-historic turned posts and railings) has a scalloped bargeboard, which suggests a late 1940s- early 1950s construction date.

At any rate, there does not appear to be sufficient historical or architectural merit to warrant individual designation as a historic landmark, so staff recommends that the applicant consider re-using the house and making an addition rather than demolishing it; the current house is very much in keeping with the character and streetscape of this section of South Austin. If re-use is not feasible, then staff recommends release of the permit upon completion of a City of Austin Documentation Package, consisting of photographs of all elevations, a dimensioned sketch plan, and a narrative history, for archiving at the Austin History Center.
